


Process for ACE Certification

Go to the ACE website: www.embcol.org

1. Review certification requirements and determine the level for which you want to apply here: <http://www.embcol.org/node/82>
2. Create new account or log in:

A. If eligible for proficiency testing waiver (ends February 28, 2011), download and complete affidavit form. <http://embcoll.org/node/106>. It has to be signed, scanned and attached in the respective part of the application form:

If you are applying for skills testing waiver, you must upload an affidavit co-signed by witness and notarized. You can only use this form to waive your ICSI skills requirements.

B. At the end of the application form: attach a copy of the following documents:

- Highest degree
- Transcripts from all schools of higher education you attended (you may be asked to submit official transcripts)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Current certification(s)
- Photo ID.
