
Process for ACE Certification

A. If eligible for proficiency testing waiver (ends February 28, 2011), download and complete affidavit form. http://embcol.org/node/106. It has to be signed, scanned and attached in the respective part of the application form:

If you are applying for skills testing waiver, you must upload an affidavit co-signed by witness and notarized. You cap only use this form to waive your ICSI skills requirements.

 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Current certification(s)
 - Photo ID.
